NATIONAL GRID RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING TIPS TO HELP MAKE SURE YOUR HOME IS WINTER READY:

- 1. HAVE THE FURNACES, CHIMNEY FLUE, SPACE HEATERS AND FIREPLACES CHECKED.
- 2. CLEAR SPACE AROUND HEAT REGISTERS, APPLIANCE VENTS AND EXHAUST DUCTS.
- 3. CLEAR CHIMNEYS AND VENTS OF BIRD OR SQUIRREL NESTS, LEAVES AND OTHER DEBRIS.
- 4. MAKE SURE THAT THE EXHAUST AND AIR INTAKE VENTS OF APPLIANCES ARE NOT BLOCKED. THESE VENTS, WHICH ARE LOCATED ON THE ROOF, AND ON THE GROUND AROUND THE OUTSIDE FOUNDATIONS WALLS FOR DIRECT VENT APPLIANCES SHOULD BE KEEP CLEAR OF SNOW AND DEBRIS.
- 5. SEAL ANY HOLES OR CRACKS THAT LET IN COLD AIR. CAULK AROUND WINDOWS AND REPLACE ANY BROKEN PANES ON STORM DOORS AND WINDOWS, WEATHER-STRIP AROUND DOORFRAMES.
- 6. CHECK INSULATION IN WALLS, CEILINGS, AND FLOORS AND ADD INSULATION AS NEEDED WHERE YOU CAN.
- 7. REMOVE WINDOW AIR CONDITION UNITS TO REDUCE DRAFTS DURING THE COLD MONTHS. IF THIS IS NOT POSSIBLE COVER ALL SIDES OF THE UNIT WITH PLASTIC.
